

**Person Specification:** Playworker

## **PURPOSE:**

To deliver afterschool care and holiday provision activities for children aged 3 to 11 years old. Provide for the social, emotional, physical and recreational needs of children by establishing and maintaining a safe, creative and stimulating environment for child's play. To provide appropriate activities for children, reflecting an understanding of the child's individual development. Work co-operatively with parents/carers, staff team and other professionals to ensure that the care and play needs of children are met. Undertake all duties within and according to the school's policies, rules and regulations and in accordance with management instructions. Promote positive values and attitudes in line with the school ethos.
