Stoneydown Park Primary School is a friendly, multicultural community school in Walthamstow, East London. The school has two sites adjacent to Stoneydown park and is two minutes' walk from bus routes and Blackhorse Road station. Walthamstow High Street and market is five minutes' walk away.

The juniors' site is a light, spacious 1960s building with a separate Nursery, twelve classrooms, teachers' workroom, resource room, Learning Mentors' room and group rooms. We have large playgrounds.

The infants' site opened in September 2014 and has 9 classrooms, a teachers' workroom, group rooms and resource rooms. The site benefits from a renovated Victorian building with a new building adjoined this to accommodate all Infant classrooms as well as an Art Classroom and Music classroom, where our specialist expert teachers deliver the curriculum.

In February 2023 we had a very positive Ofsted inspection with the school being judged as 'good'. We have continued to develop the school and are proud of our strong core subject teaching, which leads to above National Standard statutory testing results as well as an exceptional arts programme, three choirs and beautiful, leafy grounds managed by our pupils and our horticultural therapist. The school values are: creativity, community and challenge.

Our school is three form entry and full in every year group. We make the very best of being a larger than average London primary through building teams, working on supportive transition structures and developing systems to ensure the smooth running of the school. Staff are valued through CPD and a well thought out series of protocols to promote workplace fulfillment. As a result, staff turnover is half of the national education figures.

Most classes have 30 pupils and all key stage 1 classes have teaching assistants. The Nursery has 26-part time pupils in the morning and afternoon and we also offer full time (30 hour) Nursery places. Our children are motivated and behave well. They represent a range of backgrounds, cultures and languages.

More informally, all staff are more than willing to help each other, share good practice, be on hand for advice and generally work together as part of a team to make Stoneydown a positive school to work in for staff, children and visitors.
