I am delighted that you are interested in applying for the Headteacher position at the Altmore & Lathom Schools Federation.

Our two schools are large and have five-forms of entry on two sites, they are successful, caring, inclusive and popular schools which are highly regarded within the local East Ham community.

Altmore, our Infant school is the hub for the management and co-ordination of provision and services for the East Ham Children's Centre; the school offers high quality EYFS provision for pre-school 2 year-olds, Nursery for 3 year-olds, Reception and Key Stage 1. Our provision provides young children with, the best start, it has safe and accessible spaces including soft play and sensory room provision, and classrooms that are child friendly spaces and consistent stimulating environments.
